Volunteer Information

There are 3 types of volunteer activities for Ski & Snowboard families: **Team Events, Race Events, and Booster Club Events.**

All of these are important to ensuring that we can continue to have a competitive team at the high school. We asked that each family assist in at least 2 areas in order to keep things running smoothly.

Team Events

Apparel: Source team spirit wear, coordinate orders.

Booster Club Rep: Sit on the Booster Club Board and serve as a liaison to the Ski & Snowboard team. Responsibilities of the Board include attending 1x/monthly meetings and serving on a Booster Club committee.

Kick-off Party Coordinator: Reserve location (Rocky Rococo's), send invite, collect funds, and order food.

Newspaper Author: Provide articles to the Middleton Times after races, which give a synopsis of the results along with any outstanding achievements.

Race Night Volunteers: *SKI ONLY* Recruit and manage parent volunteers for MHS-host night and other races that need support.

Conference Meet Snacks: Conference is all day on Monday, Feb. 8, 2016 at Cascade. Typically involves coordinating donations of food from parents for full day. Bring or arrange a table, tent and setup of the food/drink station.

Race Night Snacks: Arrange for snacks, water, & hot chocolate for race nights by organizing donations from parents. Bring or arrange a table and setup of the food/drink station.

Pasta Dinner Coordinator: Organize the food and supplies for 2-3 team dinners during the season. Typically involves creating a Signup Genius and ensuring that there are volunteers and food for the night. Held on the Sunday nights before the first race and Conference race (Jan 3 & Feb 7, 2016) at the Middleton Fire Station; contact Norm Arendt njarendt@tds.net.

Photography / Slide Show: Put together slideshow with photos from the season.

Senior Poster: *Coordinate photo, sponsors, and printing for a seniors-only Ski & Snowboard poster. Proceeds go to team fund.*

Team Basket for Booster Tailgate: *Coordinate a themed basket for the Booster Tailgate Party, held in February.*

End-of-Year Banquet: *Held at the High School in March. Determine food, decorate, and organize volunteers for banquet. Communicate event and collect payment.*

State Meet: *Determine hotel location, reserve room blocks, coordinate dinners and food for race days. (Ski & Snowboard).*

Website: *Keep team website up-to-date with current information and links to related sites.*

Yearbook: *Work with MK (Robin Kourakis), the Yearbook teacher, to ensure that YB has good team and individual photos and good placement in the yearbook.*

Race Events

Parents are asked to volunteer/staff in many different areas on race nights. Middleton is responsible for the January 2, 2017 race and is expected to staff all areas. The positions differ slightly for Ski & Snowboard, but include on-hill and off-hill activities.

Booster Club Events

The Ski & Snowboard Team receives a significant amount of their funding from the Booster Club. Money is earned through family memberships with the Booster Club and through volunteering in concessions or at the Booster Club Tailgate party.

A sport receives \$1,000 for volunteering 50-99 hours, in a given year (7/1 – 6/30). A sport will receive an additional \$1,000 if they volunteer 100+ hours.
